- -Evidence that chapters 12 & 13 go together: Found in the repetition of key words and themes.
- -"On that day": Can refer to the final vindication of God's people or the day in which His people are justified and sanctified.
- -Several passages of Scripture: Refer to God as 'the Fountain of life' or the 'Fountain of living waters.'
- -The shedding of blood necessary for the forgiveness of sins: Found in Zechariah 12:10 and 13:7.

-Our consideration of the uncleanness of the body: Helpful in considering uncleanness of the soul

-The sanctification of God's people: On display in verse 2.

-What went hand-in-hand with the worship of idols: The false teaching of false prophets.

-The false prophets in this passage: Deny they are false prophets, put off their prophet's attire, lie about their work, and lie about the wounds they have received.

-Verse 7: A marvelous prophecy about the death of the Good Shepherd on behalf of His sheep.

-A better translation of the last part of verse 7: "I will turn My hand upon the little ones."

-Verses 8-9: Pertain to God's refining work in sanctifying His people.
